<p>E-nomination Process (Partners ONLY)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Partner sign in to our online nomination portal (link sent by e-mail - beginning of March and end of August) • Fill in the home university information • Fill in the nomination form as many times as necessary • Specify the courses (Cf. Above "Fields of studies" and "Languages") taken by each nominated student, AND the necessary adjustments required (extra time, alternate exam conditions, etc)
<p>Online Application Deadline (Students)</p>	<p>1st semester (autumn) & Full year: from March 15 to May 30 2nd semester (spring): from August 30 to October 18</p> <p>We DO NOT accept late application</p>
<p>Application Process (Students)</p> <p>1st Step</p> <p>-Mandatory-</p>	<p>The International Officer of our faculty, send by e-mail, the online application process directly to the nominated student.</p> <p>The MANDATORY documents are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • certificate on the ability of French (no official certification required, a letter from home university confirming B1 level of French can be provided). OLS test is NOT accepted. • learning agreement signed by the 3 parts (Student, Responsible person at the sending institution and our Pedagogical Coordinator) • identity photo (will be used for student card) • cover letter* • all academic transcripts of records* • curriculum vitae* <p>* The last three documents are not required by our department (only). Students can upload blank documents</p>
<p>Registration Process (Students)</p> <p>2nd Step</p> <p>-Mandatory-</p>	<p>1st semester (autumn): Between June and July 2nd semester (spring): A month prior arrival</p> <p>The MANDATORY documents for registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport or ID (copy) - Driver's licence not accepted • Registration form (sent by e-mail to the students) <p>It's only once the 2 steps have been finalised by students (application & registration), that they will be certain of being able to follow courses at our university, once they arrive in Grenoble.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: the affiliation to the student social security is no longer part of the registration process at the university. Health web page to find out more.</p>

Notification of Decision (Letter of Acceptance)	1st semester (autumn): until May 30 2nd semester (spring): until October 18
Housing Application deadline	1st semester (autumn): usually until the last week of June 2nd semester (spring): from October to mid-November
Orientation Week -Mandatory-	1st semester (autumn): last week of August until the 1st week of September 2nd semester (spring): 1st or 2nd week of January Exact dates and activities will be sent by e-mail to selected students a month prior to arrival. <p style="text-align: center;">We DO NOT accept late arrival</p>
Courses start date	1st semester (autumn): 2nd week of September 2nd semester (spring): 2nd or 3rd week of January

Types of Courses (Cf. our Specific & preferential courses above)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specific courses (CS) designed exclusively for exchange students. • Preferential courses (CP) recommended to exchange students for their academic relevance, classes with French students) • General courses (CG) which are part of the general catalogue of the university.

<p>Learning Agreement / OLA</p>	<p>Student must provide a learning agreement during the application (template must be given by the sending institution). Only our pedagogical coordinator validates and signs it. For student on an Erasmus+ exchange, the OLA will only be approved once the letter of admission will be sent (not during the application).</p>
<p>Certificates of Arrival / Attendance/ Departure</p>	<p>We don't give any documents to incoming students, but the international officer will sign documents from the home university.</p>
<p>Transcript of Records</p>	<p>ONLY electronic copy will be edited 1st semester (autumn): March 2nd semester (spring): June If re-sit exams: July</p>
<p>Specific study needs</p>	<p>Student will upload the support plan/necessary adjustments (in english or french) from the home university at the time of the registration, and will receive the procedure once in Grenoble.</p>
<p>French Courses</p>	<p>20 hours are offered to all students (3 ECTS if passed and included in the learning agreement) 1st semester: during the Orientation week (August/September) 2nd semester: during the 2nd semester</p>
<p>Buddy System</p>	<p>Once selected, all students have the possibility to join our buddy system (link will be sent by e-mail after students have been accepted). It's about connecting student-volunteers with incoming international students in order to provide the international students a helping hand before their arrival and also during their mobility.</p>
<p>Visa</p>	<p>We don't process visa applications. Any questions should be addressed to the sending universities or embassies concerned.</p>
