<p>E-nomination Deadline (Partners)</p>	<p>1st semester & Full year : from March 15 to April 30 2nd semester: from August 30 to September 30</p>
<p>E-nomination Process (Partners ONLY)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Partner sign in to our online nomination portal (link sent by e-mail - beginning of March and end of August) • Fill in the home university information • Fill in the nomination form as many times as necessary • Specify the courses (Cf. Above "Fields of studies" and "Languages") taken by each nominated student, and the necessary adjustments required (extra time, alternate exam conditions, etc)
<p>Online Application Deadline (Students)</p>	<p>1st semester & Full year: from March 15 to May 30 2nd semester: from September 15 to October 18</p>
<p>Application Process (Students)</p> <p>1st Step</p>	<p>The International Officer of our faculty, send by e-mail, the online application process directly to the nominated student.</p> <p>The required documents are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • all academic transcripts of records (no need to be translated) • curriculum vitae • certificate on the ability of French (no official certification required, a letter from home university confirming B1 level of French must be provided) • cover letter • learning agreement signed by the 3 parts (Student, Responsible person at the sending institution and our Pedagogical Coordinator) • identity photo (will be used for student card)
<p>Notification of Decision (Letter of Acceptance)</p>	<p>1st semester: until June 15 2nd semester: until November 15</p>
<p>Housing Application deadline</p>	<p>1st semester: usually until the last week of June 2nd semester: from October to mid-November</p>

<p>Registration Process (Students)</p> <p>2nd Step</p>	<p>1st semester: Between June and July 2nd semester: A month prior arrival</p> <p>Mandatory documents for registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport or ID (copy) • Registration form (provided by our faculty and sent by e-mail to the students) <p>IMPORTANT: the affiliation to the student social security is no longer part of the registration process at the university. We strongly recommend to read the Health web page to find out more.</p> <p>It's only once the 2 steps have been finalised by students (application & registration), that they will be certain of being able to try courses at our university, once they arrive in Grenoble.</p>
<p>Orientation Week</p> <p>-Mandatory-</p>	<p>1st semester: last week of August/1st week of September 2nd semester: 2nd week of January</p> <p>Exact dates and activities will be sent by e-mail to selected students a month prior to arrival</p>
<p>Courses start date</p>	<p>1st semester: 2nd week of September 2nd semester: 2nd or 3rd week of January</p>
<p>Courses end date</p>	<p>1st semester: 3rd week of December 2nd semester: 1st week of May</p>
<p>Exam Period</p>	<p>1st semester: 3rd week of December & 2nd week of January 2nd semester: 1st to 3rd week of May</p>
<p>Re-sit Exams</p>	<p>1st semester: 2nd week of June 2nd semester: 3rd week of June</p>
<p>Transcript of Records</p>	<p>ONLY electronic copy will be edited</p> <p>1st semester: March 2nd semester: June If re-sit exams: July</p>
<p>Specific study needs</p>	<p>Student will upload the support plan/necessary adjustments from the home university at the time of the registration.</p>

French Courses	<p>20 hours are offered to all students (3 ECTS if passed and included in the learning agreement) 1st semester: during the Orientation week (August/September) 2nd semester: during the 2nd semester</p>

Learning Agreement / OLA	<p>Only our pedagogical coordinator validates and signs it. If you are enrolled on an Erasmus+ exchange, the OLA will only be approved once you have received your letter of admission.</p>
Certificates of Attendance/ Departure	<p>We don't give any documents to incoming students, but the international officer will sign documents from the home university.</p>
Visa	<p>We don't process visa applications. Any questions should be addressed to the partner universities or embassies concerned.</p>
